Oklahoma Community Health Centers Celebrate National Health Center Week by Honoring "Health Care Heroes"

July 24 – Oklahoma City: From Tishomingo to Tahlequah, community outreach events, health fairs, and new facility open houses are taking place in recognition of National Health Center Week (NHCW), August 10-16. "America's Health Centers: Home of America's Health Care Heroes" is the 2008 NHCW theme. The Oklahoma Primary Care Association (OPCA), in conjunction with Community Health Centers (CHCs) across the state, will celebrate health center growth and honor "health care heroes" -- health professionals dedicated to providing a 'medical home' to all Oklahomans. Health Care for the Homeless Day will be observed on Wednesday, August 13, to focus on a population often left outside of the mainstream health care system. Governor Brad Henry signed a State Proclamation officially recognizing August 10-16 as Health Center Week in the State of Oklahoma. A complete calendar of events is attached, and the public is welcome at all locations.

CHCs, as public-private partnerships, serve all community residents and receive federal funds from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) to deliver high quality, affordable health care to uninsured patients who are below 200% of federal poverty (FPL) on an income-based sliding fee scale. CHCs provide primary and preventive care, behavioral health and substance abuse counseling, oral health services, pharmacy, lab and x-ray making affordable, high quality health care available to everyone -- including those with Medicaid, Medicare, no insurance, major medical coverage, or full-coverage insurance. Prescription drug costs are also 37%-52% less due to CHC participation in federal 340b drug pricing, with the savings passed on to the patient. "Due to community commitment and hundreds of dedicated advocates, an estimated 120,000 women, men and children of all ages in and near Oklahoma CHCs will now enjoy excellent preventive, primary, oral and behavioral health services" said Greta Stewart, OPCA Executive Director.
